He has authored and co-authored five books and about 80 scientific articles, published in *Neural Networks*, *Journal of Behavioral and Experimental Economics*, *Advanced Studies in Contemporary Mathematics*, *Proceedings of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences*, etc. His book *Decision Science: A Human-Oriented Perspective* was published by Springer Verlag.
